Management Committee – Terms of Reference

The Terms of Reference are to:

- Ensure the development, implementation and monitoring of plans for the recruitment, development and assessment of umpires, umpire assessors, umpire coaches and umpire managers at Regional level
- ensure the formulation and implementation of a policy for the selection of umpires for Regional level matches
- be responsible for the management of all funds of the NHUA and the appointment of an Auditor for the accounts.
- Appoint the Chair of Selectors, Panel Leads and Umpire Coach Developer.
- Appoint the Indoor Committee
- Appoint the Chair of North RYUAG
- ratify the appointments of the Secretary, Treasurer and the Appointments Co-ordinator of the RYUAG from nominations made by the North RYUAG.
- appoint outdoor and indoor umpire Assessors from nominations made by the NHUSP or North RYUAG.
- appoint the Welfare Officer
- investigate any actions of any member or proposed member which, i breaches EH's Code of Conduct. If proved NHUAMC may withdraw or refuse membership as appropriate
- resolve complaints and questions arising in the affairs of the NHUA
- Any complaint against a Member of NHUA that cannot be resolved by the NHUAMC must be referred to NHA. Additionally, any appeal from 5.1.10 and 5.1.11 must be referred to NHA.
- submit nominations, as required, for any Regional or National committees or sub-committees and appoint representatives, as required, to committees of the NHA.
- The NHUAMC shall meet at least 3 times per year.
